1. Editorial

This special issue of the APBREBES Updates on Plant Variety Protection is published on the occasion of the Sixth Meeting of the Governing Body of the International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture. It points at a timely new publication by Third World Network (TWN) and Berne Declaration on the interrelations between ITPGRFA, WIPO and UPOV as far as Farmers' Rights are concerned. It also highlights the submission by several CSOs jointly with the Wageningen Genebank, and the message from 107 farmers' seed networks to the member governments of the Governing Body.
